he school was established in 1960 by Smt. Minati Chanda, a trained and experienced Montessorian as the first privately managed English Medium School adopting the Montessorimethod of instruction at the Pre-Primary stage.

The school aims to promote the development of the child's social skills, emotional prints and body and mind coordination, and to prepare him or her for future intellectual and physical activities. This is done through the use of Montessori apparatus and methodologies in bright and well equipped class-room with individual seating arrangement suitable to the age group the child belongs to. Children completing their Pre-Primary education gets automatic admission into Class 1 of South Point School for their onward studyupto class 12.

Assignments/Assessment

Assignments are given on worksheets and most reading and exercise study materials are kept in school so that children are not required to carry any substantial load in their school bags. Class assignments are done through apparatus work, worksheet, exercises etc. There are no examinations or home work given. All completed and evaluated assignments and worksheet are returned to the parent / guardian at the end of each term with a detailed progress assessment.

Terms

The academic session of school has two terms, the first starting from April to September and the second from October to March.

Activities

As part of class activities, Art & Craft, Dance, Songs with Action and Apparatus work are regularly taken up with the children. Nature Study and Games with Apparatuses and other equipments are taken up as a part of outdoor class activities & field trips.







School Facilities

Medical Support

The School has contracted an NGO, Project Child to provide all kinds of medical support to our students including first aid, ambulance, qualified nurse, access to hospital on emergencies, health check up with record keeping, monitoring of school canteen etc.



Hygiene

The School employs full time Janitors for proper maintenance of school premises. Lady attendants (balsevikas) remain in constant attendance in every class room to attend to the children's toilet and hygiene needs.

Audio-Video Aided Class Rooms

To make the learning experience more enjoyable and effective for children, audio-video equipments are provided and utilized by the teachers as part of the classroom activities in school.

Play Ground

School has two exclusive play areas, one outdoor and the other indoor with play station areas. Outdoor activities are organized on a daily basis as part of the regular school day of the children. Lady attendants (balsevikas) assist the teachers to attend to all needs and ensure the safety and security of the children in their care.

Transportation

The school provides school bus service which is payable for 12 months and is optional.





School Record Book

The School Record Book supplied provides all information about the school, rules and regulations applicable to children studying in this school and their guardians, and should be brought to school everyday. Parents/Guardians and teachers may also communicate with one another through the school record book. Academic calendar with holiday list are furnished to parents/guardians at the time of admission and re-admission of students.

Parents Teachers Meet

Parents/Guardians Teachers Meetings are held regularly where Parents/ Guardians can interact with teachers and discuss their children's progress and achievements in school. All parents/ guardians are expected to attend these Meets.



Vacation

The school remains closed for summer vacation during the month of July/ August for 30 days, from 25 December to 1 January as winter break. The school remains closed on Independence Day, Republic Day, Mahatma Gandhi's birthday and some other major festivals, and for two weeks after the completion of the session.

Cultural Function

A cultural function for the children is organized every year doing November/ December to showcase their talents and training.

School Timing

The school starts at 9am and gets over at 12:30pm every day from Mondays to Fridays. There is no school on Saturdays.

Fee Refund Policy

- A. Before scheduled commencement of session (first working day of school)
- 1. If admission is sought to be cancelled after having been taken, at any time before scheduled commencement of the session, 75% of the total fee paid may be returned, irrespective of which date admission had taken place.
- 2. No refund of fee is permitted once the academic session has started and admission is sought to be cancelled, irrespective of which date the admission had taken place.
- B. After scheduled commencement of session (first working day of school)
- 1. If admission is sought to be cancelled after having been taken, at any time on or after scheduled commencement of session (first working day of school), then the following rules will be applicable:
- a) 75% of the total fee will be refunded if the admission is sought to be cancelled within 3 (three) days of taking the same.
- b) 60% of the total fee will be refunded if the admission is sought to be cancelled within 7 (seven) days of taking the same.
- c) 50% of the total fee will be refunded if the admission is sought to be cancelled within 15 (fifteen) days of taking the same.
- d) No refund of fee is permitted in case of cancellation of admission beyond 15 days of taking the same.
