I am pleased to welcome all our esteemed members to the annual general meeting of South Point Montessori School for the year 2017-2018.

At the very outset, let me share with you the very good performance of our students in the All India Secondary School Examination (10<sup>th</sup> Boards) and All India Senior Secondary Certificate Examination 12<sup>th</sup> Boards (in 2018). This time 10<sup>th</sup> board examinees were awarded absolute percentage of marks and our school topper Paramita Saha secured 98.8% overall in it.
